Dinair acquires Finnish Halton Clean Air Oy

Dinair acquires Finnish Halton Clean Air Oy, thereby taking another step in its growth plan. The agreement, which was signed 27/1 in Helsinki, provides Dinair with a service network and a broader technology base in the form of specialist knowledge and new filter



concepts. The two companies complement each other well and the combination of them will benefit Dinair Group customers in all its markets.

Fredrik Särnehed, CEO of Dinair: "Dinair see the acquisition of Halton Clean Air Oy as a continuation of our strategy to grow into a European player on the filter market for indoor air quality, industrial processes and environmental protection, a market that is highly fragmented and offers opportunities for structural rationalization. The Nordic region has unique expertise in this area and on this basis we will grow organically and through acquisitions. Dinair's concept of balanced filter selection promotes the well-being of people and generates significant energy savings for hospitals, industry, public buildings and housing."

Dinair Group is headquartered in Vadstena and the company had a turnover, before the acquisition of Halton Clean Air Oy, of 233

MSEK. With the new acquisition Dinair's turnover will be over 300 MSEK.

The company is owned by the environmental fund Alder together with the founders.
